HE HATH put down the mighty from / their seat, * and hath exalted the / humble and meek.


HE HATH filled the hungry with / good things; * and the rich he hath sent / empty away.


HE REmembering his mercy † hath holpen his servant Is/rael; * as he promised to our forefathers, Abraham and his / seed for ever.


GLORY be to the Father and to / the Son, * and / to the Holy Ghost.
