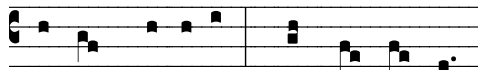
O God the Father of heaven, **have me-rcy up-on us.**

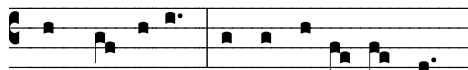
All ye holy men and women, Saints of God, **in-ter-cede for us.**

Be thou merciful, **gra-cious-ly hear us, O Lord.**



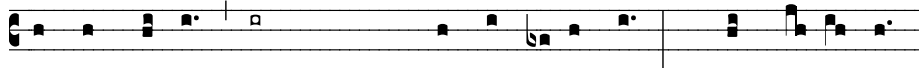
From all e-vil, **de-liv-er us, O Lord.** From all sin, **deliver...**



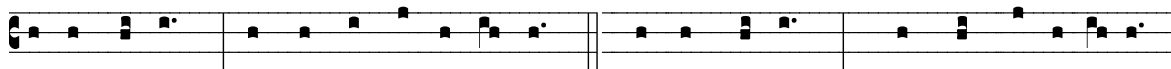
We sinners, **be-seech thee to hear us.**



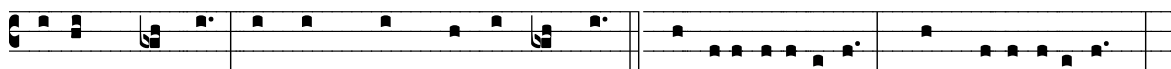
That thou wouldest spare us, **we be-seech thee to hear us.** That it may please thee to govern...
