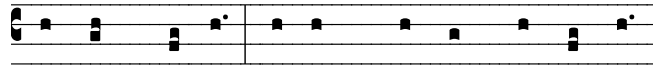

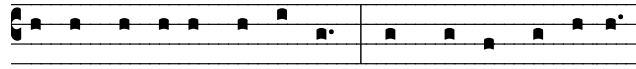

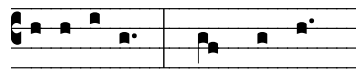

O Christ, hear us. **O Christ, gra-cious-ly hear us.**



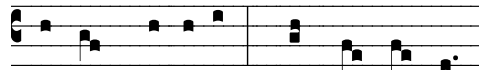
O God the Father of heaven, **have me-rcy up-on us.**  
O God the Son, Redeemer of the world, **have mercy upon us...**



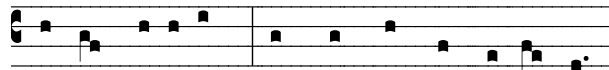
Holy Mary, **pray for us.** Holy Mother of God, **pray...** *And the Litany continues in this manner until:*



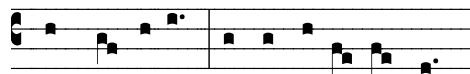
All ye holy men and women, Saints of God, in-ter-cede for us.

Be thou merciful, **gra-cious-ly hear us, O Lord.**



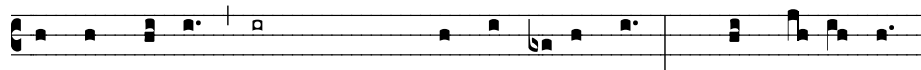
From all e-vil, **de-liv-er us, O Lord.** From all sin, **deliver...**



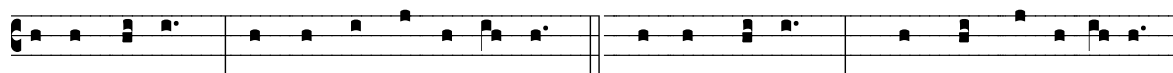
We sinners, **be-seech thee to hear us.**



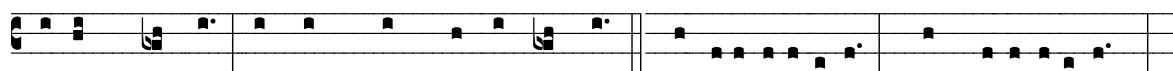
That thou wouldest spare us, **we be-seech thee to hear us.** That it may please thee to govern...
