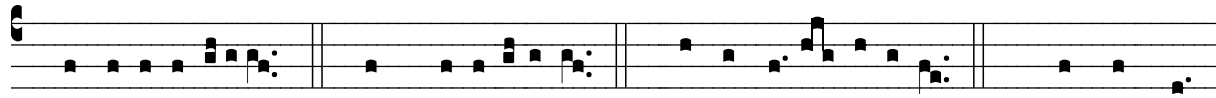


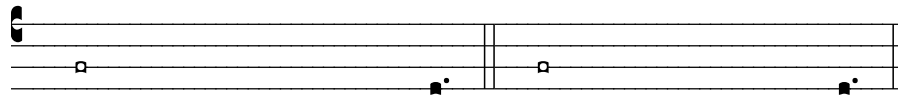
At the Absolution

The choir sings the Responsory Deliver me, O Lord while the clergy and acolytes gather at the bier. Then is sung:

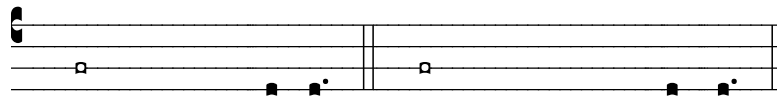

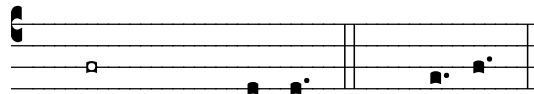
And the remainder of the prayer is said silently as the priest censes the pall and sprinkles it with holy water, until



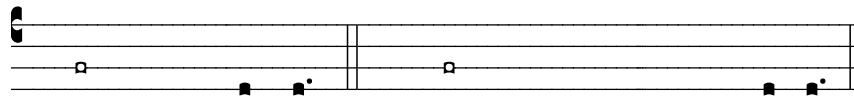
V. And lead us not into tempta-tion. *R.* **But deliver us from e-vil.**



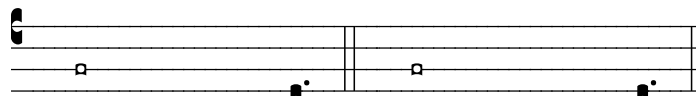
V. From the gates of hell. *R.* **Deliver their souls, O Lord.**



V. May they rest in peace. *R.* **A-men.**

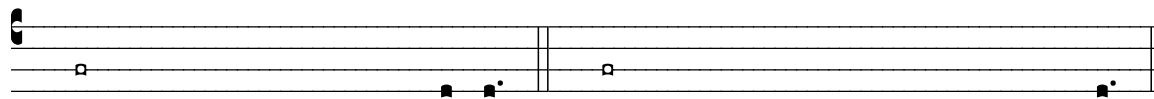


V. O Lord hear my prayer. *R.* **And let my cry come un-to thee.**

Then follows the collect O God, whose nature...

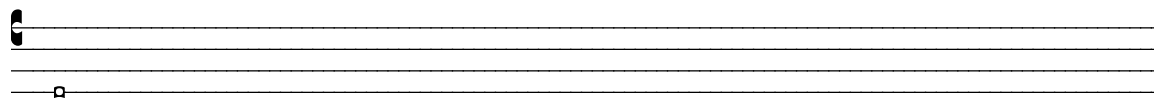


V. Rest eternal grant unto them, O Lord. *R.* **And may light perpetual shine upon them.**
